## **National Youth Parliament Festival 2019: Be The Voice of New India**

*Find Solutions and Contribute to Policy*

### **Guidelines for Participation**

#### **I. Background**

The Honourable Prime Minister shared the idea of youth becoming the voice of India in his Mann ki Baat address of 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2017:

*“I got an idea whether we could organize a mock parliament in every district of India? Where the youth between 18 and 25 could sit together and brain storm about new India, find ways and chalk our plans. How could we realize our resolves before 2022? How could we build an India of the dreams of our freedom fighters?”*

He categorically spoke about giving a chance to the youth to put forth their views on various issues concerning the country.

*“I propose that a mock Parliament be organized... comprising one young person selected from each district who would participate and deliberate on how a new India could be formed in the next five years. How can resolve be transformed into reality?”*

He reiterated his desire to organize the District Youth Parliaments in his address at time of the inaugural of the 22nd National Youth Festival on 12<sup>th</sup> January 2018.

#### **II. OBJECTIVES OF ORGANISING THE NATIONAL YOUTH PARLIAMENT FESTIVAL**

- To hear the voice of youth between 18 and less than 25 years of age, who are allowed to vote but cannot stand as a candidate for election, through deliberations in Youth Parliaments at district level and above.
- To encourage the youth to engage with public issues, understand the common

man's point of view, form their opinions and express it in an articulate manner

- To develop and enhance decision making abilities
- To develop in them a respect and tolerance for the views of others.
- To develop in them an understanding that respect for rules is essential for conducting any discussion systematically and effectively.
- To obtain and document their opinions on Vision of New India in 2022.
- To make available their views to policy makers and implementers to take it forward.

### **III: CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPATION**

- Youth, to participate in Youth Parliament must be above 18 and less than 25 years of age as on 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2018. The onus will be on the participant to furnish correct information in this regard. Furnishing of false information will lead to disqualification from participation in the Parliament at whatever stage.
- Proof of age (in original) is to be carried by participant and will be checked before start of Walk-in process for screening for District Youth Parliament (DYP) and start of District Youth Parliament (DYP) for which any of the following documents can be accepted: class 10 certificate; birth certificate; passport; voter ID card; driving licence; pan card; Aadhaar card. A copy of the certificate is to be provided to the organisers.
- The individual need not necessarily be a student of an educational institution to participate in the Youth Parliaments.

### **IV: FORMAT**

- Youth Parliaments will be conducted at three levels:
  - a) District Youth Parliament (DYP) will be conducted at the district level. Preliminary rounds of screening will be conducted to select youth for participation in the DYP. The youth will be selected through two screening processes i.e. digital & walk-in (explained below).
  - b) State Youth Parliament (SYP): The youth selected by a Jury from the District Youth Parliament will participate at the State level in SYP.
  - c) National Youth Parliament (NYP): The youth selected by a Jury from the State Youth Parliament will participate at the National level in NYP.

- The themes and subjects will be provided to the participants to conduct and facilitate participation at each of the above levels.

#### **IV: TIMELINE**

- Preliminary rounds for screening for participation in the District Youth Parliament (DYP):
  - a) Digital Process: Registration of participants and uploading of contents through YouTube video on mygov portal ([innovate.mygov.in/youth-parliament](http://innovate.mygov.in/youth-parliament)): 12th to 18th January, 2019.
  - b) Walkin Process: Screening at designated Institutions in the Districts: 17th to 19th January, 2019
- District Youth Parliament (DYP) to be organised inspecified districts: 24th to 28th January, 2019
- State Youth Parliament (SYP): 05th to 07th February, 2019
- National Youth Parliament (NYP): 23rd to 24th February, 2019

#### **VI: SELECTION PROCESS**

##### **A: Selection at District Level**

##### ***1. Preliminary screening for participation in the District Youth Parliament (DYP): 12th to 18th January, 2019***

##### **1.1: Digital Process: 12th to 18th January, 2019**

Individuals to record their speech of 90-120 seconds on any one of the given subjects and upload the videos on youtube. The participants will register at MyGov site ([innovate.mygov.in/youth-parliament](http://innovate.mygov.in/youth-parliament)), provide information and then provide link of youtube video. The video will be screened by a two member Screening Committee preferably of an educationist and an eminent member of the area. Multiple Committees may be set up depending on volume of participants.

The Evaluation Criteria for digital screening to select participants for District Youth Parliament (DYP) will be as given below:

- a) Articulation/Eloquence
- b) Content knowledge
- c) Clarity of thought

Each of the above evaluation criteria will carry 30 points. Final evaluation will be made out of 90 points. Maximum of 50 participants in order of merit per district will be selected for participation in District Youth Parliament (DYP).

### **1.2: Walk-in Process: 17th to 19th January 2019**

Individual candidates can also walk-in & appear for screening at designated venues (known as Nodal Institutions) from 10 am to 5 pm from 17th to 19th January 2019. Any Youth within prescribed age bracket can walk-in and register at the designated Nodal Institution. Screening of youth registering at Nodal Institution for participation in District Youth Parliament (DYP) will be done by a two member Screening Committee by hearing each of the registered youth for 2 to 3 minutes. The Screening Committee will comprise preferably of an educationist and an eminent member of the area. Multiple Committees may be set up depending on volume of participants. The details of Nodal Institutions are at Annexure I.

The Evaluation criteria for selecting participants through Walk-in for District Youth Parliament will be as given below:

- a) Articulation
- b) Content knowledge
- c) Clarity of thought
- d) Demeanour

Each evaluation criteria will carry 25 points. Final evaluation will be made out of 100 points. Maximum of 50 participants per district will be selected in order of merit by the Screening Committee for participation in District Youth Parliament (DYP).

### **2. Conduct of District Youth Parliament (DYP): 24th to 28th January 2019**

The District Youth Parliament (DYP) of the youth selected by the above two processes will be conducted in specified Districts. For practical reasons two or three Districts may be clubbed to make it more participatory and qualitative. Therefore, the DYP will be held in 494 districts across the country and the details of the Districts where the DYP will be held are at Annexure II.

A panel of 5 best speakers will be finalised by the Jury in order of merit in case there is a dropout. The three (3) best speakers from each District Youth Parliament (DYP) will participate at the State level. A certificate of merit will be awarded to the best speakers from the DYP in the panel. Every participant will be given a certificate of participation (format will be provided by Ministry).

The evaluation criteria to select speakers for State Youth Parliament by the Jury will be as given below:

- a) Articulation
- b) Clarity of Thought
- c) Content knowledge
- d) Demeanor

Each evaluation criteria will carry 25 points. Final evaluation will be made out of 100 points.

**B: Selection at State Level**

***Conduct of State Youth Parliament (SYP): 05th to 7th February 2019***

Winners from each DYP to sit together in State Youth Parliament (SYP) and deliberate on various issues in the presence of a Jury. The details of the Venue where the SYP will be held are at Annexure III.

The evaluation criteria to select speakers from SYP for participation in the National Youth Parliament (NYP) will be as under:

- a) Articulation
- b) Clarity of Thought
- c) Content knowledge
- d) Demeanour

Each evaluation criteria to carry 25 points. Final evaluation will be made out of 100 points. The concerned Jury will prepare a panel of 4 best speakers in order of merit in case there is a dropout. The 2 best speakers from each State Youth Parliament (SYP) will participate at the national level. A certificate of merit will be awarded to the best speakers from the State in the panel. Every participant will be given a certificate of participation (format will be provided by Ministry).

## **C: Selection at National Level**

### **Conduct of National Youth Parliament (NYP)**

The final stage of the National Youth Parliament (NYP) will be held at New Delhi. Two (2) winners from each State will participate as speakers in the National Youth Parliament (NYP). In addition to this, the highest scorer from each District in the District Youth Parliament (DYP) will participate in the National Youth Parliament (NYP) as a delegate. Hence, around 700 participants are likely to participate in the National Youth Parliament (NYP) representing each district of the country. If a person is selected as a speaker for National Youth Parliament and is also the highest scoring speaker from the District then the next highest scorer from that district will be deputed as delegate to National Youth Parliament. The evaluation criteria to select the winners of the National Youth Parliament (NYP) by concerned Jury will be as under:

- a) Articulation
- b) Clarity of Thought
- c) Content knowledge
- d) Demeanour

Each evaluation criteria to carry 25 points. Final evaluation will be made out of 100 points. The three best speakers at the national level will be awarded Rs 2 lakhs, Rs 1.50 lakhs and Rs 1 lakh respectively alongwith a certificate of merit. Every participant will be given a certificate of participation (format will be provided by Ministry).

## **VII: LANGUAGE**

The youth can participate in Hindi, English or the official language of the State Government concerned from which the youth is participating at level of screening for DYP; DYP & SYP.

## **VIII: JURY**

Jury will be set up at all three levels i. e. District, State and National levels. The Youth Parliaments i.e. DYP, SYP & NYP will each be adjudged by a five (5) member Jury. Each Jury will be comprised of the following members:

- Parliamentarian/Member of Legislative Assembly/Eminent political leader
- Retired/serving officers including uniformed service officers
- Eminent artist /Social Personality
- Eminent journalist/writers

- Educationist

At District and State levels, relevant local eminent personalities will be included to form the Jury. At the National final, nationally eminent personalities will be included in the Jury.

## **IX: TOPICS FOR DISCUSSION**

The topics for discussion at different levels will be released as per following details:

1. Topics for Digital Process for screening for DYP: 12th January 2019
2. Topics for Walk-in Process for screening for DYP: 15th January 2019
3. Topics for DYP: 22nd January 2019
4. Topics for SYP: 3rd February 2019
5. Topics for NYP: 20th February 2019

## **X: TREATMENT OF DATA**

The data documented in the process will be the property of Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports.

## **XI: LOGISTICS**

For District Youth Parliament (DYP), the participants will not be provided any travel cost or any other logistical support. They have to bear all expenses.

For State Youth Parliament (SYP), the participants will be provided boarding & lodging facility & their travelling expenses (ordinary bus/ sleeper class train fare) will be reimbursed.

For National Youth Parliament (NYP), the participants will be provided boarding & lodging facility and the travelling expenses (ordinary bus/ sleeper class train fare) will be reimbursed.



**INSTRUCTIONS TO FIELD FORMATIONS FOR CONDUCT OF NATIONAL  
YOUTH PARLIAMENT FESTIVAL 2019**

**All field level officers are to refer to the Guidelines for Participation in National Youth Parliament Festival 2019 issued by the Department (Annexure 1). These Instructions are issued under the above referred Guidelines.**

**THE ROLE OF THE NSS PROGRAMME OFFICER (PO) OF NODAL  
INSTITUTION**

**a) For Walk-in screening of Participants from 17.01.19 to 19.01.19 to be conducted at Nodal Institution**

1. Programme Officer of the nodal institution will be Nodal officer and responsible for conduct of walk-in screening.
2. District Youth Coordinator (NYKS) of each district will help & support the PO in organizing the entire programme and in computing results.
3. It is ensured that signage is put up suitably in campus to facilitate walk-in candidates. Use posters provided by NSS Headquarters for publicity at relevant places.
4. PO & DYCs and all support teams are fully versed with the details with respect to conduct of Walk-in process. Concerned must have copies of the Guidelines of Participation referred to above.
5. Information regarding registration will be disseminated wide and far to ensure that more and more youth come and register to participate in District Youth Parliament. The name of the Nodal Institution should be clearly and widely publicized.
6. PO will set up a support team of minimum 20 NSS volunteers to assist in conduct of walk-in screening. This team would be divided into registration team, ushering team, Logistics and computation team.
7. A mock drill will be conducted by 15.01.2019 with registration team, usher team, computing team and screening committee to ensure that everyone understands the process well and any issues related to smooth conduct of walk-in process is suitably addressed.
8. Ushering team will be constituted to guide the participants coming for walk-in screening. It will guide them to registration desks and also share information about the process.

9. Registration Team will set up a reporting/registration table at appropriate place in Nodal Institution with NSS Volunteers to register walk in's. It will register details of each youth who reports for participation. Participants will be required to fill the prescribed form and they would be assigned a serial number on first come basis. It will also organise the record for being retained. The participants would be allowed to speak before screening committee in the order of their assigned serial number.
10. Registration would be open for 3 days from 17.01.19 to 19.01.19 from 10 am to 5 pm. However the PO will have flexibility to extend the closing time, as per requirement.
11. The Screening team would consist of 2 members, preferably, one being an academician having experience of conducting debates and another an eminent person of the District.
12. The PO will be in contact with the Screening Team well before start of walk-in. Brief the screening committee about the guidelines and evaluation criteria in advance and provide scoring sheet for marking.
13. Ensure that screening committee is provided with all logistical support. Screening committee should have an independent room with no outside disturbance for walk-in screening. They will be suitably equipped with facilities like table, chairs, etc. A team of NSS Volunteers may be assigned for ensuring and managing all logistics.
14. Each youth shall be given a chance to speak for two to three minutes on a given subject.
15. Create Computing Team of minimum 4 NSS volunteers to compute and update scorecard of marks given to participants by screening committee in excel sheet. Programme officer will ensure that computers are provided to the computing team.
16. The services of the NSS Volunteers engaged in the walk-in process will be counted as part of their 120 hours of community service.
17. On 20.01.19 a consolidated merit list of all walk-in participants is prepared and the best 50 speakers are selected for participation in District Youth Parliament.
18. SNO and RD will share the list of around 50 participants selected through digital medium with Programme Officer of nodal institution for walk in by 20.01.19.
19. A consolidated list of participants for District Youth Parliament in designated districts, selected through Digital medium and walk-in would be prepared latest by 21.01.19 morning.

20. All selected participants for District Youth Parliament (through walk in and digital medium) shall be informed by 21.01.19 evening latest.

**b) Preparation for District Youth Parliament from 24.01.19 to 28.01.19 to be conducted at designated Districts**

1. The NSS Programme officer of institute designated to conduct District Youth Parliament will receive the consolidated list of participants of all districts in their cluster by 21.01.19 from PO of nodal institution where walk-in screening was conducted.
2. Ensure that signage is put up suitably at venue to facilitate District Youth Parliament participants.
3. A team of minimum 25 volunteers would be created to assist in conduct of District Youth Parliament. They will be divided into age registration & verification team, ushering team, computation team and logistics/support to Jury team.
4. The ushering team will guide participants about process and guide them to the Registration desk.
5. The registration and Age verification team will perform the function of registering the participants; obtaining necessary information; allotting a serial number on first come basis and carrying out age verification of selected participants. The verification process should commence before the start of District Youth Parliament from 8:30 am onwards. The verification team should be fully briefed about documents that can be accepted for verification and on how to maintain record. The record will be retained.
6. Proof of age (**in original**) is to be carried by the participants. Following documents would be considered for age verification: class 10 certificate; birth certificate; passport; voter ID card; driving licence; pan card; Aadhaar card. A copy of the relevant certificate is to be provided to the organizers by the participants.
7. Youth found ineligible as per guidelines shall not be allowed to participate in District Youth Parliament.
8. District Youth Parliament should commence from 10 am onwards.
9. Logistics Team will ensure all logistics viz availability of cordless mike, PA system and proper seating arrangements for the participants & Jury, and also provision of safe drinking water and other essential amenities at the venue. Backdrop provided by NSS Headquarter should be used for DYP.

10. The services rendered by NSS Volunteers shall be counted as part of their 120 hours of community service.
11. The Programme officer of institute will coordinate and brief the Jury about the conduct of the DYP and provide them with the guidelines, criteria of selection and scoring sheet.
12. Computing team will compute the score card in an excel sheet. PO of the institution will ensure that computer is provided to the team.
13. Programme Officers will ensure documentation of the District Youth Parliament and capturing it in Audio-Visual medium.
14. The merit list will be consolidated between 29/30.01.19 and shared with SNO and RD by 30.01.19 afternoon.
15. Report of the programme conducted will be shared with SNOs and RDs within 3 days of the conduct of programme.
16. Provide Utilization Certificate of funds spent in execution of the program to SNO.

## **ROLE OF NYKS DISTRICT YOUTH COORDINATOR (DYC)**

1. DYCs will mobilize rural youth, through their youth clubs, to participate in District Youth Parliament and encourage them to register digitally on mygov portal ([innovate.mygov.in/youth-parliament](http://innovate.mygov.in/youth-parliament)) and also participate for walk-in screening in the nodal institution.
2. The DYCs will coordinate with Programme Officers of NSS for smooth conduct of all activities detailed above and help them at each stage in execution of the walk-in screening and District Youth Parliament.
3. DYC will also assist the Programme Officer in coordinating with District Administration for conducting of District Youth Parliament in designated districts between 24.01.19 to 28.01.19. DYC would meet the District Magistrate/ District Commissioner and inform about the programme
4. DYCs will engage their National Youth Volunteers and youth club members wherever required in facilitating the organization of District Youth Parliament in designated Districts.
5. The DYCs will also help Programme Officers in ensuring the publicity of the Programme through local media.
6. DYC's will be particularly responsible for uploading content of day to day activities on the NYKS website. Similar efforts will be made by the NSS Team.

### **ROLE OF NYKS STATE DIRECTORS (SD)**

1. State Director will be responsible and accountable for smooth and successful conduct of District and State Youth Parliaments in their State alongwith Regional Directors of NSS.
2. State Directors will read the guidelines regarding role of RDs and SNOs and coordinate and facilitate in execution of the programme at each stage.
3. SDs will issue necessary directions to the DYCs, circulate the guidelines and brief them personally.
4. They will keep monitoring the preparation of each district for walk-in screening between 17.01.19 to 19.01.19 and conduct of District Youth Parliament in designated districts between 24.01.19 to 28.01.19.
5. They shall facilitate to resolve issues highlighted by DYCs in coordination with RDs and SNOs.
6. The State Directors will direct DYCs to help Programme Officers in publicity of the Programme through local media.
7. They will coordinate with the State NSS Officers and Regional Directors of NSS to locate the venue and identify Jury members and coordinate with local members for smooth conduct of State Youth Parliament.
8. The State Directors will facilitate in smooth conduct of State Youth Parliament between 05.02.19 to 07.02.19

## **ROLE OF STATE NSS OFFICER AND REGIONAL DIRECTOR**

### **a) Preparation for Digital Screening of Participants from 12.01.19 to 18.01.19**

1. To coordinate with digital screening committee and suitably equip them for screening between 12.01.19 to 18.09.19
2. For digital screening provide an independent room with minimum three computers with high speed internet facility. Also keep alternate data card in case one network fails to perform at required speed.
3. Brief the digital screening committee about their roles and responsibilities.
4. MyGov will share the participants youtube link with the screening committee in 95 centers on 15.01.19, 17.01.19 and 18.01.19 for evaluation.
5. Create computer assistance team of minimum 3 volunteers well versed with computer operation to assist the screening committee whenever required.
6. Share the compiled list provided by MyGov of selected candidates through digital screening process with DYCs and POs of nodal institution latest by 20.01.19.

### **b) For Walk-in screening of Participants from 17.01.19 to 19.01.19**

1. Share with POs the format of registration, scoresheet for walk-in screening.
2. Provide template of posters for publicity.
3. To co-ordinate with the head of the institution, Principal/Dean and facilitate the Programme Officer to conduct walk-in screening of participants in nodal institutions between 17.01.19 to 19.01.19
4. To share all instructions and guidelines provided from NSS Directorate (HQ) with POs of nodal institution for walk-in screening and PO of institution conducting District Youth Parliament and brief them about their roles and responsibilities.
5. To ensure that the results of walk-in are computed by 20.01.19

### **c) Preparation for District Youth Parliament from 24.01.19 to 28.01.19 to be conducted at designated Districts**

1. Ensure through POs of nodal institution that consolidated list of walk-in screening and Digital screening is prepared by 21.01.19
2. Ensure that all participants for District Youth Parliament are informed by 21.01.19 latest.
3. To coordinate with district authorities, institutional head of designated venue for conduct of District Youth Parliament.
4. Remain in touch with POs and DYCs of NYKS to take stock of preparation and be available to address any issue.

5. Provide them backdrop template and posters.
6. Consolidate the list of selected participants for State Youth Parliament on the basis of result of District Youth Parliament by 30.01.19 evening.
7. Ensure all the selected participants for State Youth Parliament are informed by 30.01.19 evening by POs and DYCs in each district.

**d) Preparation for State Youth Parliament from 05.02.19 to 07.02.19 to be conducted at designated Districts**

- a) To identify a premier institute at the State capital or in any other prominent district in the State for conduct of State level Youth Parliament between 05.02.19 to 07.02.19
- b) To co-ordinate with the State Government to conduct State Youth Parliament. They will meet the Secretary/ Director of the concerned department in the State Government and inform about the programme.
- c) Place signage to guide the participants.
- d) Arrange for Boarding and lodging of the participants.
- e) Provide transport for participants from place of stay to venue.
- f) Create Accommodation team of NSS volunteers to assist the participants, Usher team to assist at venue, Computation team to compute the results, organizing team to assist in preparation of venue and any other team they require. For the same volunteers be identified well in advance and briefed properly.
- g) To manage and organize all logistics required like mike, PA system and other required facilities.
- h) To provide the list of possible jury members matching the jury guidelines to the Directorate/Ministry.
- i) NSS Headquarter/Ministry would provide the final list of the jury members for State level.
- j) To co-ordinate with jury members and ensure their presence.
- k) Provide the Jury members their guidelines and evaluation score sheet.
- l) Compute results by 09.02.19 in excel sheet and send it to NSS (HQ) by 09.02.19 evening.
- m) To submit Utilization Certificate to NSS Directorate (HQ) within fifteen days of conduct of programme in their State.
- n) A composite report of the programme conducted in each district and in State shall be shared with NSS Headquarter within 5 days of the conduct of programme.
- o) To bring to the notice of the NSS Directorate if any problem crops up during the due process.

**e) Overall Responsibility**

- Regional Directorate and State Nodal (NSS) Officers would be responsible and accountable for conducting of walk-in in each district, District Youth Parliament in designated Districts and State Youth Parliament in the States under their jurisdiction.



- State NSS Officer (SNO) would be the nodal officer for conducting Youth Parliament in their respective States. They will work in coordination with State Directors of NYKS, assigned with task to facilitate and coordinate.

### **Guidelines for Jury**

- It is to be ensured that the selection procedure is absolutely fair and transparent
- Articulation, Clarity of thought and content knowledge is to be given preference.
- Maximum 3 minutes to be given for a speaker. Non-adherence to time limit is subject to penalty.
- Political statements not to be considered for evaluation
- Aggregate of marks of all Jury members to be the criteria for determining merit
- In case two or more participants secure same marks, then the older of the participants will be placed higher in order of merit.
- The objective is not to criticize opinions, but to collate implementable and scalable ideas, which come out of this discussion.

## राष्ट्रीय युवा संसद महोत्सव 2019 : नए भारत की आवाज

समाधान करें और नीति में अपना योगदान करें

### भागीदारी के लिए दिशानिर्देश

#### I. पृष्ठभूमि

माननीय प्रधानमंत्री जी ने 31 दिसंबर 2017 को अपने संबोधन मन की बात में युवाओं को भारत की आवाज बनने के अपने विचार को साझा किया।

“मेरे मन में एक विचार है कि क्या हम भारत के प्रत्येक जिले में एक मॉक संसद का आयोजन कर सकते हैं? जहां 18 और 25 वर्ष की आयु के बीच के युवा एक साथ बैठेंगे और नए भारत के बारे में विचारों का आदान-प्रदान करेंगे और समाधान बताएं तथा योजनाओं का खाका तैयार करेंगे। हम अपने संकल्पों को 2022 से पहले किस प्रकार प्राप्त कर सकते हैं? हम अपने स्वतंत्रता सेनानियों के स्वप्नों के भारत का निर्माण कैसे करेंगे?”

माननीय प्रधानमंत्री जी ने युवाओं को देश से जुड़े विभिन्न मुद्दों पर अपने विचार प्रकट करने के लिए उन्हें अवसर देने के बारे में विशेष बल दिया।

“मेरा प्रस्ताव है कि प्रत्येक जिले से एक युवा का चयन करके एक मॉक संसद का आयोजन किया जाए जो इसमें भागीदारी करेंगे और इस बात पर विचार विमर्श करेंगे कि अगले 5 वर्षों में किस प्रकार एक नए भारत का निर्माण किया जा सकता है? हम किस प्रकार अपने संकल्प को वास्तविकता में बदल सकते हैं?”

माननीय प्रधानमंत्री जी ने अपने भाषण में 12 जनवरी, 2018 को 22वें राष्ट्रीय युवा महोत्सव के शुभारंभ के समय जिला युवा संसद आयोजित करने की अपनी इच्छा को दोहराया।

#### II. राष्ट्रीय युवा संसद महोत्सव आयोजित करने के उद्देश्य

\* जिला स्तर और इससे ऊपर के स्तर पर युवा संसद में विचार-विमर्श के माध्यम से 18 वर्ष से 25 वर्ष की आयु के उन युवाओं की आवाज सुनना जो अपने मताधिकार का प्रयोग कर सकते हैं परंतु चुनाव में उम्मीदवार के रूप में चुनाव नहीं लड़ सकते।

\* युवाओं को जनता के मुद्दों में सहभागिता के लिए प्रोत्साहित करना, आम आदमी के विचारों को समझना, अपनी राय बनाना और उसे प्रखर तरीके से अभिव्यक्त करना।

\* निर्णय लेने की क्षमता का विकास करना और उसमें वृद्धि करना।

\* युवाओं में अन्य व्यक्तियों के विचारों के प्रति सम्मान और सहिष्णुता का भाव विकसित करना।

\* उनमें यह समझ विकसित करना कि किसी भी चर्चा को व्यवस्थित और कारगर ढंग से करने के लिए नियमों का अनुपालन अनिवार्य है।

\* 2022 में नए भारत के विजन पर उनकी राय प्राप्त करना और उनका प्रलेखन करना।

\* नीति निर्माताओं और इनका कार्यान्वयन सुनिश्चित करने वालों को युवाओं के विचारों के बारे में अवगत कराना ताकि उन पर अमल किया जा सके ।

### III. भागीदारी के लिए मानदंड.

\* युवा संसद में भाग लेने वाले युवाओं की आयु 30 जून 2018 को 18 वर्ष से अधिक परंतु 25 वर्ष से कम होनी चाहिए। इस संबंध में सही सूचना उपलब्ध कराने का उत्तरदायित्व प्रतिभागी का होगा। किसी भी स्तर पर गलत सूचना देने पर प्रतिभागी संसद में भाग लेने के अयोग्य हो जाएगा।

\* प्रतिभागी को आयु संबंधी प्रमाण-पत्र (मूल प्रति) देना होगा और इसे डीवाईपी की वॉक-इन प्रक्रिया में जाँच से पहले और जिला युवा संसद (डीवाईपी) शुरू होने से पहले सत्यापित किया जाएगा। इस प्रयोजन के लिए निम्नलिखित दस्तावेज स्वीकार्य हैं- कक्षा 10 प्रमाण पत्र, जन्म प्रमाण पत्र, पासपोर्ट, मतदाता पहचान पत्र, ड्राइविंग लाइसेंस, पैन कार्ड, आधार कार्ड। प्रमाण पत्र की एक प्रति आयोजकों को उपलब्ध कराई जानी अपेक्षित है ।

\* युवा संसद में भागीदारी के लिए प्रतिभागी का किसी शैक्षणिक संस्थान का छात्र होना अनिवार्य नहीं है।

### IV. फॉर्मैट

\* युवा संसद का आयोजन तीन स्तर पर किया जाएगा:

क) जिला युवा संसद (डीवाईपी) जिला स्तर पर आयोजित की जाएगी । जिला युवा संसद में भागीदारी के लिए युवाओं का चयन करने हेतु स्क्रीनिंग के प्रारंभिक दौर आयोजित किए जाएंगे । स्क्रीनिंग की दो प्रक्रियाओं अर्थात डिजिटल और वाक-इन (walk-in) (इसकी व्याख्या नीचे दी गई है) के माध्यम से युवाओं का चयन किया जाएगा।

ख) राज्य युवा संसद (एसवाईपी): जिला युवा संसद से जूरी द्वारा चयनित युवा राज्य स्तर पर राज्य युवा संसद में भाग लेंगे।

ग) राष्ट्रीय युवा संसद (एनवाईपी) जूरी द्वारा राज्य युवा संसद से चयन किए गए युवा राष्ट्रीय युवा संसद में भाग लेंगे ।

## VI. चयन प्रक्रिया

क: जिला स्तर पर चयन

I. जिला युवा संसद (डीवाईपी) में भागीदारी के लिए प्रारंभिक स्क्रीनिंग: 12 से 18 जनवरी, 2019

### 1.1: डिजिटल प्रक्रिया: 12 से 18 जनवरी, 2019

प्रतिभागियों को दिए गए विषयों में से किसी एक पर 90-120 सेकेंड का अपना भाषण रिकार्ड करना होगा और उसका वीडियो यूट्यूब पर अपलोड करना होगा। प्रतिभागी Mygov site (innovate.mygov.in/youth-parliament) रजिस्टर करेंगे, सूचना उपलब्ध कराएंगे और उसके बाद यूट्यूब वीडियो का लिंक देंगे। इस वीडियो की स्क्रीनिंग दो सदस्यीय स्क्रीनिंग समिति जिसमें अधिमानतः एक शिक्षाविद और एक उस क्षेत्र का विख्यात सदस्य होगा, द्वारा की जाएगी। प्रतिभागियों की संख्या के आधार पर अनेक समितियां गठित की जा सकती हैं।

जिला युवा संसद (डीवाईपी) के लिए प्रतिभागियों का चयन करने के लिए डिजिटल स्क्रीनिंग हेतु मूल्यांकन मानदंड इस प्रकार हैं:

क) वाकपटुता/ वाकदक्षता

ख) विषयवस्तु का ज्ञान

ग) विचारों की स्पष्टता

उक्त प्रत्येक मानदंड के लिए 30 अंक होंगे। अंतिम मूल्यांकन 90 अंकों में से किया जाएगा। जिला युवा संसद (डीवाईपी) में भागीदारी के लिए योग्यता के क्रम में प्रति जिला अधिकतम 50 प्रतिभागियों का चयन किया जाएगा।

## 1.2: वॉक-इन प्रक्रिया: 17 से 19 जनवरी 2019 तक

- (ग) विचारों की स्पष्टता

प्रत्येक मूल्यांकन मानदंड के 25 अंक होंगे। अंतिम मूल्यांकन 100 अंकों में से किया जाएगा। जिला युवा संसद में (डीवाईपी) में भागीदारी के लिए स्क्रीनिंग कमेटी द्वारा मेरिट के क्रम में प्रति जिले से अधिकतम 50 प्रतिभागियों का चयन किया जाएगा।

## 2. जिला युवा संसद (डीवाईपी) का आयोजन: 24 से 28 जनवरी 2019

उपरोक्त दो प्रक्रियाओं द्वारा चुने गए युवाओं की जिला युवा संसद (डीवाईपी) का आयोजन निर्दिष्ट जिलों में किया जाएगा। व्यावहारिक कारणों से दो या तीन जिलों को एक साथ क्लब किया जा सकता है ताकि इसमें युवाओं की अधिक भागीदारी और गुणवत्ता हो। इसलिए, देश भर के 494 जिलों में डीवाईपी आयोजित जाएगी और डीवाईपी आयोजित किए जाने वाले जिलों का विवरण Annexure-II में दिया गया है, जिसको उक्त लिंक पर भी देखा जा सकता है - [innovate.mygov.in/youth-parliament](http://innovate.mygov.in/youth-parliament)

ड्रॉपआउट को ध्यान में रखते हुए निर्णायक समिति द्वारा 5 सर्वश्रेष्ठ वक्ताओं के एक पैनल को योग्यता के क्रम में अंतिम रूप दिया जाएगा। प्रत्येक जिला युवा संसद (डीवाईपी) के तीन (3) सर्वश्रेष्ठ वक्ता राज्य स्तर पर भाग लेंगे। डीवाईपी के पैनल के सर्वश्रेष्ठ वक्ताओं को प्रशस्ति प्रमाण

पत्र प्रदान किया जाएगा। सभी प्रतिभागियों को सहभागिता प्रमाण पत्र प्रदान किये जाएंगे (प्रारूप मंत्रालय द्वारा दिया जाएगा)।

निर्णायक समिति द्वारा राज्य युवा संसद के लिए वक्ताओं के चयन हेतु मूल्यांकन मानदंड नीचे दिए गए हैं :

- (क) वाक दक्षता(आर्टिक्यूलेशन)
- (ख) विचारों की स्पष्टता
- (ग) विषय का ज्ञान
- (घ) आचरण (डीमेनओर)

प्रत्येक मूल्यांकन मानदंड 25 अंकों का होगा। अंतिम मूल्यांकन 100 अंकों में से किया जाएगा।

एसवाईपी से राष्ट्रीय युवा संसद (एनवाईपी) में भागीदारी के लिए वक्ताओं का चयन करने हेतु मूल्यांकन मानदंड इस प्रकार होंगे।

- (क) वाक दक्षता(आर्टिक्यूलेशन)
- (ख) विचारों की स्पष्टता
- (ग) विषय का ज्ञान
- (घ) आचरण (डीमेनओर)

प्रत्येक मूल्यांकन मानदंड 25 अंकों का होगा। अंतिम मूल्यांकन 100 अंकों में से किया जाएगा। ड्रॉपआउट को ध्यान में रखते हुए संबंधित निर्णायक समिति द्वारा 4 सर्वश्रेष्ठ वक्ताओं के एक पैनल को योग्यता के क्रम में अंतिम रूप दिया जाएगा। प्रत्येक राज्य युवा संसद (एसवाईपी) के 2 सर्वश्रेष्ठ वक्ता राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर भाग लेंगे। राज्य के सर्वश्रेष्ठ वक्ताओं के पैनल में चयनित वक्ताओं को प्रशस्ति प्रमाण पत्र प्रदान किया जाएगा। सभी प्रतिभागियों को सहभागिता प्रमाण पत्र प्रदान किये जाएंगे (प्रारूप मंत्रालय द्वारा दिया जाएगा)।



## **ग: राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर चयन**

### **राष्ट्रीय युवा संसद (एनवाईपी) का आयोजन**

राष्ट्रीय युवा संसद (एनवाईपी) का अंतिम चरण नई दिल्ली में आयोजित किया जाएगा। प्रत्येक राज्य के दो (2) विजेता राष्ट्रीय युवा संसद (एनवाईपी) में वक्ताओं के रूप में भाग लेंगे। इसके अतिरिक्त, प्रत्येक जिले से एक जिला युवा संसद (डीवाईपी) में सर्वाधिक अंक प्राप्त करने वाला प्रतिनिधि के रूप में राष्ट्रीय युवा संसद में भागीदारी करेगा। इसलिए, राष्ट्रीय युवा संसद (एनवाईपी) में 700 प्रतिभागियों के भाग लेने की संभावना है जो देश के प्रत्येक जिले का प्रतिनिधित्व करेंगे। यदि राष्ट्रीय युवा संसद में वक्ता के रूप में चयनित युवा अपने जिले का अधिकतम अंक प्राप्त करने वाला प्रतिभागी है, तो उसके बाद जिस प्रतिभागी के अधिकतम अंक है वह उस जिले के प्रतिनिधि के रूप में राष्ट्रीय युवा संसद में भाग लेगा। संबंधित निर्णायक मंडल द्वारा राष्ट्रीय युवा संसद (एनवाईपी) के विजेताओं का चयन करने के लिए मूल्यांकन मानदंड निम्नानुसार होंगे:

प्रत्येक मूल्यांकन मानदंड 25 अंकों का होगा। अंतिम मूल्यांकन 100 अंकों में से किया जाएगा। राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर 3 सर्वश्रेष्ठ वक्ताओं को प्रशस्ति प्रमाण पत्र के साथ क्रमशः 2 लाख रु, 1.5 लाख रु और 1 लाख रु का पुरस्कार दिया जाएगा। सभी प्रतिभागियों को सहभागिता प्रमाण पत्र प्रदान किये जाएंगे (प्रारूप मंत्रालय द्वारा दिया जाएगा)।

## **II: भाषा**

युवा हिंदी, अंग्रेजी या उस राज्य सरकार की शासकीय आधिकारिक भाषा का प्रयोग कर सकता है जिससे युवा डीवाईपी की जाँच; डीवाईपी और एसवाईपी के लिए भागीदारी कर रहा हो।

## **VIII: जूरी**

तीनों स्तरों अर्थात जिला, राज्य और राष्ट्रीय स्तरों पर जूरी की स्थापना की जाएगी। युवा संसद अर्थात डीवाईपी, एसवाईपी और एनवाईपी, प्रत्येक का मूल्यांकन पांच (5) सदस्य वाली जूरी द्वारा किया जाएगा। प्रत्येक जूरी में निम्नलिखित सदस्य शामिल होंगे:

- सांसद / विधान सभा के सदस्य / प्रख्यात राजनेता
- सेवानिवृत्त / सेवारत अधिकारी जिनमें सेना के अधिकारी भी शामिल हैं
- प्रतिष्ठित कलाकार / सामाजिक हस्ती

- प्रख्यात पत्रकार / लेखक
- शिक्षाविद्

जिला और राज्य स्तर पर, प्रासंगिक स्थानीय प्रतिष्ठित व्यक्तियों को जूरी में शामिल किया जाएगा। राष्ट्रीय स्तर की समिति में ऐसे व्यक्तियों को जूरी में शामिल किया जाएगा जो राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर प्रख्यात हों।

#### **IX: चर्चा के लिए विषय:**

विभिन्न स्तरों पर चर्चा के लिए विषयों को निम्नलिखित विवरणों के अनुसार जारी किया जाएगा:

5. एनवाईपी के लिए विषय: 20 फरवरी 2019
