Subject: Prohibition of sales of Tobacco Product as in the area within a radius of 100 yards of any educational institution.

Kindly refer to subject cited above.

With respect to Gazette notification registered No. DL333004/2003DL issued from Ministry of Law and Justice and Legislative Department on dated 19th May 2003 on the Cigarettes & other Tobacco product Act (COTPA), 2003 vide Section - 6

“No person shall sell, offer for sale, or permit sale of cigarette or any other tobacco product –

- (a) to any person who is under eighteen years of age, and
- (b) in an area with a radius of one hundred yards of any educational institution.

As per explanation Section – 24

- (1) Any person who contravenes the provision of section 6 shall be guilty of an offence under this Act and shall be punishable with fine which may extend to two hundred rupees.
- (2) All offences under this section shall be compoundable and shall be tried summarily in accordance with the procedure provided for summary trials in the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

In the view of above mentioned proceedings, you are humbly requested to provide the District wise list of Primary, High, Higher Secondary Schools & Colleges which are Tobacco Free among the State of Haryana, in the view Section- 6, B of Cigarettes & Other Tobacco Product Act (COTPA), 2003.
