

To meet this short-coming, the Department of Higher Education, Haryana and the Department of Technical Education, Haryana shall be airing radio shows to promote distance-learning/learning-from-home through radio. These half-an-hour sessions shall be broadcast all over Haryana using all four major Aakashwani Radio Stations in Haryana, at a common time.

The students of Haryana are the main target audience of the broadcast, so that they are able to learn by the radio platform, as well. The two half-an-hour sessions shall be broadcasted daily, on the topics decided by the teachers, themselves. Kindly, appoint subject experts to prepare and record the sessions for the radio broadcast.

Please identify important topics from all subjects under all courses, and appoint your best academicians, professors, domain experts and scholars to record the half an hour audio lecture/talk/session. Please note that the session

should be recorded in a high quality wav file format. In case it is not feasible to get a recording in wav format, please ensure that a clear and high quality mp3 file is sent across to the Department.

The audio files should be sent on digigyanhry@gmail.com before July 1, 2020. The subject experts are free to choose the topics for sessions of the broadcast that are beneficial for the education of the students pursuing higher and/or technical education, giving due priority to the importance of the topic in examinations and in the practical/professional life, and equal weightage to all subjects, across all courses offered under the Department(s).
