Hon'ble CM has approved Drug Prevention plan for Higher Education Institutions which are as follows:

1. One "Youth against Drugs Club" in each college to be made.
2. This programme may be called 'DOST' and tagline of this programme is 'Swasth, Shasakt and Sajag Yuva'.
3. Special Task Force needs to be made at the State Level led by Home Department, where one representative from Education department will be there.
4. A volunteer from amongst the teacher or if no volunteer then a teacher selected by the Principal of the college will be trained as 'Master trainer' in the State Level Workshop to be organized at Chandigarh/ Panchkula in which we may invite senior Police Officers, Doctors, Psychologists, NGOs, NCB Officials to share their experience.
5. These master trainers will then train all other teachers in colleges/universities. The students will self monitor and also help others by spreading awareness.
6. College will select a student as 'DOST' in each class to keep observation on any student/classmate behaving oddly or may be taking drugs and will immediately bring it to the notice of his teacher.
7. A structured programme may be developed with a calendar of activities to be organized in colleges/ universities under this programme. We may hold talks from the young achievers, survivors who are now successful to narrate their de-addiction experience, organize poster making competitions, short movie making competitions, debate, drama, declamation, essay writing, Student poetry/songs, youth festival with the theme of substance abuse, half marathon etc.
8. All colleges will adopt 5 nearby villages to launch a door to door campaign against drugs and will also identify drug users in the college or in their surrounding so that he may be persuaded to go for the rehab.
9. Posters and publicity material may be put up at all strategic points in and outside the college. This material may be provided by the Health Department.
10. 24 x 7 online help line for students may be rolled out which also keep their identity discreet. All DCs will take a monthly review of all colleges/universities regarding the activities undertaken by them.
11. Cultural Affairs Department may be asked to get a song done on the "Youth against drug abuse" which may be given wide publicity.
12. All activities (curricular & extracurricular) in the college should have drug abuse as one of the themes.
13. Wall paintings or Mosaic showing ill effects of drugs maybe done at strategic points on the campus.
14. CCTV Cameras in academic area of college and nearby surroundings are to be fitted to keep a watch on drug peddlers.
15. Local SHO, ACP and SP/DCP to give a talk to students as outreach programme so that student can approach them freely in case they have information on drug trafficking or have a doubt.
16. NSS, NCC or NYKS units may be invited to be a part of the campaign.
