**Subject: Implementation of NEP 2020 – actions to be undertaken by Govt. & Govt. Aided Colleges**

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I have been directed to convey to you that the below mentioned 30 action points need to be implemented on priority basis in all the HEI's in the State of Haryana. As you are aware that the National Education Policy (NEP 2020) replaces the 34-year-old National Education Policy (NEP) that was formulated in 1986.

To implement NEP 2020 in a timely and effective manner, the entire higher education ecosystem needs to commit itself to build trust between all stakeholders including Higher Education Institutions (HEIs), Government authorities, and regulatory bodies. Higher Education Department, Haryana has initially identified some action points which can be immediately taken up by the colleges to ensure implementation of NEP as per the detail mentioned below :-

1. Mandatory accreditation by NAAC
2. Participation in India Ranking
3. Institutional Development Plan
4. Moving towards autonomous colleges or graded autonomy
5. Telepresence & availability of smart class-rooms
6. Enrolment in hostels
7. Faculty development - trainings and refreshers
8. Numbers of research papers/books published by faculty during last one year
9. International conferences attended by faculty/students.
10. Leadership development programmes attended by Principal
11. Industry interaction and orientation of faculty towards implementation of industry linked curriculum.
12. Setting up of incubation centres to promote start-ups, promote technological development, research and entrepreneurship
13. Introducing innovative certificate courses
14. Choice Based Credit system in colleges
15. Onboarding of Colleges on Academic Bank of Credit portal
16. Use of ICT in pedagogy /Use of LMS
17. Active student clubs

18. Formative assessment of students
19. Efforts for the physical fitness of students
20. International MoUs and setting up of International Affairs office in colleges
21. Proper performance evaluation matrix of faculty
22. Engagement of senior PG students as teaching assistants
23. Scholarships through industry/corporates
24. Internships with industry/corporate (MoUs)
25. Remedial classes for weaker students
26. Skill based add on courses
27. Interaction of all colleges in a district for use of common facilities
28. Subscription to research journals in college libraries
29. 100% digital colleges
30. Self-assessment and internal audit of all Colleges through Prayaas Framework

A web-portal to monitor progress on all above parameters is being built by the department and expected to be made live shortly (further instructions in this regard shall soon follow).

All the Colleges (Govt. & Govt. Aided) are expected to initiate action on the above NEP components immediately.
