1. The complainant has submitted that as per Section 16 & 17 of RPwD Act, 2016, the respondents are duty bound to comply with the beneficial provision for the persons with disabilities in all the educational institutions either run by State Government or aided or recognized (self-financed). Hence the issues raised by him in the complaint are required to be addressed not only for him but all other similarly situated students studying in the various colleges and Universities of State Of Haryana.
2. The representatives for the respondents submit that they shall ensure the compliance of Section 16 and 17 of the RPwD Act, 2016 in letter and spirit and for that purpose shall take all necessary steps within a period of two months so that the compliance of all provisions of RPwD Act, 2016 are complied with w.e.f. session of 2022-23.

In view of above, the present case is adjourned to 22.02.2022 with a direction to the respondents to submit detailed reply supported with duly sworn affidavit of the competent authority specifying steps taken for the implementation of the provisions of RPwD Act, 2016 in all the colleges/universities of Haryana either run by the State or aided or self-financed. It should also be mentioned in the aforesaid affidavit about the mechanism to ensure that no violation is made by any authority/college/University etc.
