Subject:- Policy on conversion from self finance courses to Grant-in-aid under budgeted posts in Govt. Aided Colleges, Haryana.

Kindly refer subject cited above

I have been directed to inform that policy on subject matter has been approved by the Govt. of Haryana with the following provisions:-

- L. Aided College with a valid NAAC grade (above B) will be eligible to make such application. To the Gove for conversion of a self-financing subject into an aided post.
- 2. The self-financing course subject which is to be converted into budgeted shall have to be approved by the State Govt and concerned University.
- 3. The conversion of a self-financing subject into an aided subject/post (s) will only be allowed if the college has any vacant aided post(s) in any subject of grant-in-aid.
- 4. In future, no aided post in the subject will be allowed to be granted again after conversion of that post from a self financing subject.
- 5. After the conversion of the self-finance subject into an aided subject post, that particular self-financing subject will be discontinued.
- 6 Dt to conversion of the particular subject post, no extra financial burden of any kind will be borne by the government.
- 7. No full self financing course like BBA. B.Com, BBM etc. will be allowed to be converted into budgeted course due to certain financial limitations like the requirement of multiple subjects, staff, labs etc.
