

2. The meeting of Officer's Committee to review the cases of Officers for retention in service beyond the age of 50/55 years was held under the Chairpersonship of the Chief Secretary on 06.11.2018. In the meeting, the various agenda were discussed in detail. During discussion, it was noted that even though the Administrative Departments have appointed the Inquiry officers in most of the cases where disciplinary action is pending, Inquiry Report is not submitted by Inquiry Officer well in time. Because of this, the action in the matter could not be finalized till the retirement of concerned Official/Officers.

3. Govt. has taken a serious view in this regard and it is specifically directed to all the concerned authorities that in such cases where the Inquiry Officers have been appointed by the concerned Departments, the Inquiry Report should be submitted by Inquiry Officer within 3 months positively, so that, action against the concerned officials/officers could be taken well in time.
