Subject:- Implementation Plan of NEP-2020 - Drafting of Thematic Paper.

Dear Vice Chancellor,

As you are aware, Ministry of Education in the recent meetings/workshops with the Administrative Secretaries of UTs and States indentified three themes namely 'Access', 'Quality' and 'Future Readiness' of NEP-2020 with 14 sub themes on which States are to come out with a consolidated report/concept paper. For this, the UTs and States have been divided into Zones and Regions. The outcome of these zonal and regional workshops is to be discussed in the forth coming proposed conference of Chief Secretaries in Feb. 2022 to be organized by NITI Aayog and followed by a Presentation before the Hon'ble Prime Minister in March 2022 (copy enciosed as Annexure-I).

MOE has now assigned the task of chairing Zone-III (12 States) workshops to Shri Anand Mohan Sharan IAS, PSHE & TE. As a follow up, the regional workshop of the States falling in Region-II has been scheduled for 20.12.2021 at Chandigarh.

Now in the capacity of leading these States by Haryana, we have to come forward in making a broad based presentation on these themes and sub themes. To have a broad band approach, State Level Committees have been constituted for each sub theme under your Chairmanship (Annexure-II). For this I am sharing with you the guidelines, templates etc. as have been made available by MOE. In addition, the Group so constituted under your Chairpersonship may also go through the relevant paras/recommendations of NEP-2020 and give recommendation as per thematic parameters enclosed with as Annexure-III.

The exercise is proposed to be carried out in association of all the stakeholders.

## General instructions for organizing these Workshops are as follows:-

- 1) Three major themes i.e. Access, Quality, Future Readiness have been identified for deliberation at Zonal / Regional level. All the themes will be discussed at Zonal and Regional level.
- 2) Three Zones and their Regional Groups, have been identified as per Annexure 1.



Details of the Zones, State/UTs covered, Regional level Coordinating HEIs, the coordinating officers of UGC/AICTE and Ministry is at Annexure 2, 3 and 4.

- 3) UGC will be facilitating coordination in Zone 1 and Zone 3and AICTE will be facilitating coordination in Zone 2.
- 4) Each Zone / Regions will be Chaired by the Senior most officials from out of the States/UTs in respective Zones.
- 5) All Secretarial assistance will be arranged by Co-ordinating officers from Ministry and similarly at the Regional Level the Secretarial assistance will be provided by the coordinating institutions in regions.
- 6) Tentative time line for various activities is at Annexure 5.
- 7) Each Zone will be Chaired by the Senior most officials from out of the States in respective Zones.
- 8) Zonal / Regional level Co-Ordinator in consultation with the Zonal / Regional Head may ensure participation of officers of different seniority, domain experts and Higher Education Institutions.
