## Subject:- Regarding Interaction of Hon'ble Prime Minister with students.

Kindly refer to the subject cited above.

I have been directed to inform you that Hon'ble Prime Minister will be interacting with students of schools and colleges on matters concerning how to reduce exam stress on 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 from 11.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon. It will be broadcast live by Doordarshan through DD National, DD News and DD India. It will also be available through live airing on radio channels (All India radio Medium Wave, All India Radio FM Channel), live web streaming on websites of PMO, MHRD, Doordarshan, My Gov.in, innovate.mygov.in and Youtube channel of MHRD, Facebook Live, and Swayamprabha channels of MHRD.

You are requested to make necessary arrangements so that all students in Universities and Colleges can view/hear the telecast.

Although most of our Institutions are equipped with TV and have electric and internet connections, in case electricity, TV and reception of TV signal (either through DTH satellite, cable or aerial antenna) is not available or in non working condition, then action to ensure that arrangements for a TV and facility for TV reception (including making arrangements for electricity that day through generators/inverters etc.) to ensure that students can view/hear the Prime Minister's live address on that day may be taken in all Colleges/Universities.

Apart from TV broadcast, the viewing facility may also be arranged through EDUSAT, and also on internet access devices (computers/laptops/mobile, etc.). Other than this, arrangements of radio may be made so that students may listen to the address of the Prime Minister.

All students must be informed of the programme through messages and notices. Information may also be forwarded to the parents so that they may also watch the programme at home. Display arrangements for the information of public may also be made.

This may be treated as the MOST URGENT and may be given TOP priority.
