Whereas Ministry of Education, Government of India circulated National Education Policy-2020 for implementation by the State Governments.

Whereas Government of Haryana on 31.07.2021 launched implementation of National Education Policy-2020 in the State and committed to achieve most of the targets by 2025 as against National target timeline of 2030.

Whereas in Para 5.23 National Education Policy-2020 has envisioned that by 2030, the minimum degree qualification for teaching will be a 4 year integrated B.Ed. degree that covers a range of knowledge, content and pedagogy and includes strong practicum training in the form of student teaching at local schools.

Whereas State Government has been running diploma in Elementary Education in District Institutes of Education and Training under centrally sponsored teacher education scheme with an intake capacity as approved by National Council for Teacher Education for each District Institute of Education and Training.

Whereas State Government has been running a 4 year integrated B.Ed. degree course in State Institute of Advanced Studies in Teacher Education, Jhajjar duly approved by National Council for Teacher Education.

Whereas in view of what has been envisioned under National Education Policy-2020 pending up-gradation of District Institutes of Education and Training, admissions to Diploma in Elementary Education have not taken place since 2018.

And therefore Government of Haryana considered the entire issue in its depth and in compliance with vision of National Education Policy-2020 introduced 4 year integrated B.Ed. program as a pilot project from 2021 academic session by up-gradation of two District Institutes of Education and Training, one each at Gurugram and Kurukshetra at the level of State Institute of Advanced Studies in Teacher Education (SIASTE) on the pattern of SIASTE Jhajjar by restricting the intake capacity as earlier approved by National Council for Teacher Education vide their orders NoF.NRC/NCTE/F.3/HR-225/dated 02.09.2004 and NoF.NRC/NCTE/F.3 /HR-217/5688-5696 /dated 07.08.2004.

The upgraded DIET Gurugram and DIET Kurukshetra shall be under the territorial jurisdiction of respective universities i.e. Gurugram University, Gurugram and Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra with the amended nomenclature State Institute of Advanced Studies in Teacher Education, Gurugram (Upgraded DIET Gurugram) and State Institute of Advanced Studies in Teacher Education, Kurukshetra (Upgraded DIET Kurukshetra).

And whereas the up-gradation of the remaining DIETs shall be considered later on keeping in view the manpower requirement (teachers) for future pace setting schools, increased enrolment and depending upon infrastructure available in each DIET.
