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Objectives of the Scheme

To improve and enhance the skills, knowledge of the existing incumbents in service through various Govt. Training institutes and apencies as a part of faculty development and capacity building programme for the teachers, administrative and the technical staff (this includes training in academics, administration and imparting of skills such as usage of technology for ushering efficiency and confidence in the incumbents). The following are the different parts of the scheme already approved:

a. Orientation & Refresher Courses/Seminar/ Conferences/Workshops

Assistant Professor/ Associate Professors. Deputy Directors in the Gozd service are required to do mandatory Orientation Courses and Refresher Courses for becoming cligible for placement under Career Advancement Scheme. Funds for organizing P.C./O.C. are included in this scheme. In addition to this capacity building of Principals and Assistant Professor/ Associate Professors will be done by giving them chance to organize attend the National / State Level Seminar/ Conferences/ Workshops etc.

b. Modular Training for Assistant Professor/ Associate Professors

It has been felt that merely these Refresher Courses & Orientation Courses do not motivate them and seldom add rigor to their intellectual capacities and confidence. Therefore, it would be appropriate to train these incumbents on regular basis to update and chisel their knowledge, skills and abilities.

This will be done by designing special programmes pertaining to the subject of teaching current topics methodology for teaching and also other skills such as usage of latest technology. Training is to be primarily for upgrading knowledge in their own subject. Some training courses may also be conducted for upgrading knowledge in computers and for improving English. The training institutions like Indian Institute of Advance Study (IIAS), National Productivity Council. New Delhi. National Institute of Rural Development, Hyderabad, NIEPA. New Delhi, HIPA, Gurugram, Indian Institute of Mass Communication, New Delhi, British Council Division, Jamia Milia Islamia and such like Institutions in India and a few training institutes outside India would be roped in for imparting these trainings. The Joint Director/ Principal of Colleges Deputy Directors are in need of value aided knowledge of new administration reforms and technique. For that they must be provided special training/course either at HIPA of any other administrative training institute of repute or visit of different universities in India or aboard. It will provide them new vision of thinking, change in attitude and behavior. Every lecturer has to undergo this training once in three years.

c. International Conferences

We have many scholars who are preparing research papers which have been approved by the foreign Universities/Organization. But due to shortage of money those scholars are unable to present papers in person. Hence, if a grant is sanctioned to those scholars who wish to present the research papers in the foreign Universities of repute then it will be a good step to encourage others also to improve their quality.

Main features of the scheme are as follows:-

- Only those scholars will be provided financial assistance whose research papers have been accepted by the foreign University of repute and the University has asked them to present papers personally.
- ii. 50% of the expenditure incurred on this educational trip will be borne by the Haryana
- iii. If the Foreign University/Organization has paid TA/DA, then only the other expenditure will be borne by the Haryana Govt, subject to maximum limit of 50%.
- iv. Every year, new scholars will be provided opportunity, in case of repetition, the scholar will be given scholarship only once in the duration of 3 years.
- v. In this scheme, only the Assistant Professor/ Associate Professors and Principals working in the field or in the Head Office will be eligible.
- vi. The scheme will, however, be operated on first come first serve basis.



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5. Introduction of Musical & Cultural Programme in Govt. College.

It was discussed at length and decided that it is mandatory for all the Govt. College to organize two days Musical and Cultural programme in the second week of February. Each College will give a unique name to this programme. In this programme activities such as music, dance, short play skit, mimiery, folk, dance, classical dance etc. will be organized. All students in the college must be encouraged and must be provided opportunity to participate in the programme Students who get 1 st., 2 and and 3rd position in all the categories should be given each prize of Residents who get 1 st., 2 and and 3rd position in all the categories should be given each prize of Residents programme and can be paid honorarium at the rate of Rs. 1000/- per day. However, the total amount spent on honorarium cannot exceed Rs. 10000/- including rehearsals. This activity may be incorporated in the existing "Human resources Development Scheme" under which a provision for Rs. 70.00 lacs has been made during financial year 2023-24.

- 6. Procedure to be followed-The funds will be distributed by the Department for holding Orientation & Refresher Courses/ Seminars/ Conferences/ Workshops at National/ International Level and Utilization Certificate will be submitted by the concerned Principal to this office.
- 7. Method of keeping Accounts:
 The cash book will be maintained by the Principal of concerned college
- 8. Procedure of the payment :-

Sanction would be accorded to Registrar Education. This office will monitor the progress of scheme at all time for effective implementation. It is a State funded scheme and it shall be of continuous nature.

9. Time frame of the scheme:-

Activity based. By 28 th February, 2024 the money will be spent as and when the trainings were held by R.C., O.C.HIPA and IDC the grant will be disbursed.

10. Eligibility Conditions:-

The Principals, Assistant Professor/ Associate Professors, Deputy Directors and Joint Directors in the Govt. Colleges and employees working in Directorates eligible for the scheme.

11. Modus Operandi of selection of beneficiaries:-

Need based and request based i.e. teacher's training. Principal's training, R.C., O.C. and HIPA/IDC trainings.

12. Pattern of assistance:-

The Principals, Assistant Professor/ Associate Professors, Deputy Directors and Joint Directors who become eligible for placement under Career Advancement Scheme are given TA/DA etc. for attending different courses. Assistance was given for attending seminar at National and International level and Modular training for Assistant/Associate Professors of colleges.

13. Utilization of the sanction at the headquarter level shall be monitored by the concerned officer Assistant Director/Deputy Director/ Joint Director.
