

- II. any stake-holder or any person interested shall be at liberty to place the material before the Haryana Backward Class Commission in this regard;
- III. the State Government, the Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Backward Classes Department and/or any other department as also

IV. the State Government shall make due and wide publication for submitting the data to the Haryana Backward Class Commission by the said date;

V. the data furnished shall be put up by the Haryana Backward Class Commission on its website;
