

Minutes of meeting held between the Director Secondary Education, Haryana and the Director Higher Education, Haryana in order to involve students of Universities and Higher Education Institutions in New India Literacy Programme (NILP) as Volunteer Teachers

The meeting was held on 03.08.2023 in the office of W/ Director Secondary Education (DSE). Haryana and Dr. Vishal Sharma. Deputy Director attended the meeting on behalf of W/ Director Higher Education. Haryana for involving students of Universities and Higher Education Institutions in New India Literacy Programme (NILP) as Volunteer Teachers. The meeting was chaired by W/DSE, Haryana and Sh. Virender Singh. Programme Officer. Literacy of Secondary Education. Haryana also attended the same. The inference of the meeting are as under:

- 1. To develop action plans with the available infrastructure.
- 2. Prepare a roaster for the community outreach programme through extension learning involving students from all HEIs to eradicate illiteracy in the state.
- 3. To be added in student course work in form of project or assignment and credits to be included for the activity of 200 hrs teaching (online/offline). Regarding this, a communication to be initiated with Universities, and Board of Studies for drafting credit-based assignment or project in course work pertaining to involve students as volunteer teacher in NILP.
- 4. The feasibility of 200 hrs teaching to be considered as one NSS camp to be explored and the students volunteer will get 1% of the marks obtained and Grade 'A' certificate for the social service rendered.
- 5. The approved targets of beneficiaries during FY 2023-24 is 5 Lakhs including target of 1.75 lakhs non-literates of 2022-23.
- 6. The total number of Government HEIs & School institutions will be provided to access the capacity to replicate this programme.

Action To Be Taken:

- I. To write letters to university / board for ratting credit-based assignment or project work in the course work (syllabus) regarding involvement of students in New India Literacy Programme (NILP) as volunteer teachers.
- II. To write letter to the Principals of Govt. Colleges, to depute NSS Incharge to make list of students willing to act as volunteer teachers in NILP and subsequently make a roster for 200 hrs teaching of the

illiterates (as per CRID Survey) of the area at the Govt. infrastructure available (School/ Community Centre/ Panchayat Offices / Higher Education Institution (Colleges).

- III. As the gestation period of the course to be accessed is 6 months, the HEIs have two cycles per annum. Average teaching-learning class interval per day should be 1 and half hour.
- IV. Preparatory activities of NILP like identification of learners & VTs (college / university students), their registration at NILP App / portal will be initiated in September, 2023 so as to appear maximum learners (15 and 15+ of years aged illiterates) in FLN Assessment Test to be conducted in March, 2024.
