Subject:- Regarding integration of Students from Jammu & Kashmir into mainstream.

Kindly refer to the subject cited above.

There is a need for integration of students from Jammu & Kashmir into national mainstream as they are some times kept at the margins and face hardships while pursuing Higher Education in other states. The State Govt. of Haryana has decided to provide following concessions to the students belonging to Jammu & Kashmir for their admissions in the Colleges and Universities of Haryana:

1. Relaxation in cut-off percentage upto 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.
2. Increase in intake capacity upto 5% -course- wise.
3. Reservation of at least one seat in merit quota in technical/professional institutions.
4. Waiving of domicile requirements.
5. Setting up of a Grievances Redressal Mechanism in every institution for students from Jammu & Kashmir.

These instructions shall be complied with in letter and spirit.
