I am directed to convey that the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, Government of India, vide D.O. letter No. NYPS/1/2024-YP dated 03.06.2025 (Copy attached) and its earlier communication dated 24.05.2024, has issued directions regarding the implementation of the National Youth Parliament Scheme (NYPS) 2.0 through its web portal (<a href="https://nyps.mpa.gov.in/">https://nyps.mpa.gov.in/</a>). The scheme aims to strengthen democratic values among students by involving them in Youth Parliament activities.

- 2. Under the revised framework:
  - Students of Classes VI to XII may participate under the Kishore Sabha category.
  - UG/PG students may participate under the Tarun Sabha category.
  - · Citizens may also participate individually through online quizzes.
  - All recognized educational institutions (Government & Private schools, universities, colleges, technical institutions, polytechnics, engineering & diploma colleges, and ITIs) are eligible to organize Youth Parliament sittings after registering on the portal.
