Subject:- Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign-2026 and Partition Horror Remembrance Day-2026.

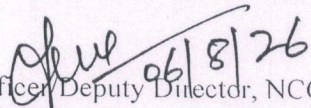
Kindly reference to video conference regarding "Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign-2026" held on 05.08.2026 under the chairmanship of the Worthy Director General Higher Education, Haryana, wherein the implementation of the campaign from 09.08.2026 to 17.08.2026 was reviewed.

In this regard, you are directed to ensure strict compliance of the following instructions during the campaign period:-

1. Organize a lecture, seminar or any other suitable activity on Partition Horror Remembrance Day on 14.08.2026.
2. Encourage students to participate in the National Online Quiz on Partition Horror Remembrance Day on the MyGov Portal from 01.08.2026 to 15.09.2026.
3. Organize exhibitions highlighting the evolution of the National Flag and the spirit of Vande Mataram.
4. Encourage community participation through student-led walkthroughs and outreach activities.
5. Organize Tiranga, Bike, Cycle and E-Bike Rallies. The route should be planned to maximize public visibility and finalized in consultation with the concerned Deputy Commissioner.
6. Ensure participation of students, youth and Government officials in Tiranga Rallies. Mass singing of Vande Mataram may be organized at the commencement of the rallies.
7. Ensure illumination and Tricolour-themed decoration of Government buildings, wherever applicable.
8. Ensure active participation of NSS Volunteers and NCC Cadets in all activities.
9. Invite Freedom Fighters, Eye witnesses to the Partition, local dignitaries and NGOs, wherever feasible, and ensure maximum participation of students.
10. Colleges not having NSS/NCC Units shall also organize activities under the Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign.
11. Further, all institutions are advised to remain in close liaison with the District Information and Public Relations Officer (DIPRO) and remain in close liaison with the District Administration concerned so as to receive any information/instructions issued from time to time regarding the above-mentioned campaign.

You are further requested to organize the above activities in a befitting manner and submit a **comprehensive Action Taken Report (ATR)**, along with geo-tagged photographs, brief activity-wise details and the number of participants, to this Directorate on email **nssmagazineharyana@gmail.com** immediately after completion of the campaign for onward submission to the Government.

The above instructions may be treated as **Most Urgent** and complied with meticulously.

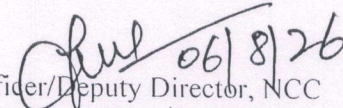
