GUIDELINES FOR STATE NSS AWARDS.

1. Introduction

1.1 National Service Scheme (popularly known as NSS), a flagship programme of the Government of India, was launched on 24 September 1969, the Birth Centenary year of Mahatma Gandhi with the primary objective of developing the personality and character of the student through voluntary community service. The ideological orientation of the NSS is inspired by the ideals of Mahatma Gandhi. Very appropriately, the motto of NSS is *"NOT ME, BUT YOU"*.

The scheme was initially started in 37 Universities of India involving 40,000 student volunteers. Today, it has approximately four million student volunteers spread over about 850 universities and +2 councils making this scheme one of the biggest social working group.

1.2 **Programme Structure**: NSS is being implemented in Senior Secondary Schools, Polytechnics, Colleges and Universities. The design of the NSS envisages that each educational institution covered under the Scheme has at least one NSS unit comprising of normally 100 student volunteers, led by a teacher designated as Programme Officer (PO). Each NSS unit adopts a village or slum for taking up its activities. An NSS volunteer is required to undertake the following work/ activities:

a. Regular NSS Activity: Each NSS volunteer is required to put in minimum 120 hours of community service per year for two years, i.e., total 240 hours. This work is undertaken in villages/ slums adopted by NSS unit or school/ college campuses, usually after study hours or during weekends.

b. Special Camping Programme: Each NSS unit organizes a Special Camp of 7 days' duration in adopted villages or urban slums, during vacations with some specific projects by involving the local communities. Each volunteer is required to participate in a Special Camp once during the 2-year period.

1.3 **Nature of Activities Under NSS**: The principle aim of NSS is *"The Personality Development of the Students through Community Service"*. In order to fulfill the objective, student volunteers and programme functionaries are engaged in constructive and productive shramdaan, social reforms, communal harmony, creation of community assets, relief work, blood donation, environmental protection, literacy programme, health education campaign, etc. Under the scheme, each volunteer contributes 240 hours of community work during a period of two years.

The NSS volunteers work on issues of social relevance, which keep evolving in response to the needs of the community, through regular and special camping activities. Such issues include (i) literacy and education, (ii) health, family welfare and nutrition, (iii) environment conservation, (iv) social service programmes, (v) programmes for empowerment of women, (vi) programmes connected with economic development activities, (vii) rescue and relief during calamities, etc.

2. STATE NSS AWARDS

2.1 The Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Govt. of India has institute National Service Scheme Awards during 1992-93 (formerly known as Indira Gandhi NSS Awards) for giving recognition to the outstanding work done under NSS by Programme coordinators, NSS Units with Programme Officers and Volunteers. As per the NSS Manual (Manual – Revised – 2006), the terms and conditions of the award at state level may be decided by the state authorities so that the State Government may also confer State NSS Awards to the best University/ College/ Senior Secondary (+2) NSS Unit with Programm Officer, Programme Coordinator and NSS volunteers who have done excellent work in the field of community development and youth work through National Service Scheme.

On the occasion of the NSS Felicitation Ceremony at Raj Bhawan Haryana on June 11th, 2018, Hon'ble Sh. Manohar Lal, Chief Minister, Govt. of Haryana announced to institute State NSS Awards from year 2018 in the following categories –

- (a) 01 University NSS Programme Coordinator,
- (b) 01 District (+2 Schools)/Polytechnic NSS Programme Coordinator,
- (c) 03 NSS Programme Officers & NSS Units and
- (d) 10 NSS Volunteers.

Therefore, as per above CM Announcements to recognize the outstanding work done by the University/ District Programme Coordinators, Programme Officers with NSS units and NSS volunteers, the criterion for the selection of State NSS Award has to be fixed and prepared as per the criterion for NSS Awards at National Level. So, to recognize the voluntary service rendered by NSS Stakeholders, it has been proposed to provide suitable incentives/ awards under the scheme.

Additional Chief secretary Higher Education had announced in State NSS Awards Function held at CCSHAU, Hisar on 24 September, 2023 that the Awards in NSS Volunteers category will increase from 10 to 20 Volunteers from NSS State Awards 2022-23. Now State NSS Awards from the year 2022-23 will be given in the following categories as per mentioned below:

- (a) 01 University NSS Programme Coordinator,
- (b) 01 District (+2 Schools)/Polytechnic NSS Programme Coordinator,
- (c) 03 NSS Programme Officers & NSS Units and
- (d) 20 NSS Volunteers.

2.2 <u>**Objective of State NSS Awards**</u>: The objectives of the State NSS Awards is to recognize and reward outstanding contributions towards voluntary community service made by the University/District (+2 Schools)/Polytechnic Programme Coordinator, NSS units/ Programme Officer and NSS volunteers, with a view to further promote NSS.

3. <u>NATURE OF THE AWARD</u>

The State NSS Awards will be given at four levels every year and the details are given below:

- a. University NSS Programme Coordinator (For NSS Programme Development at University Level)
- b. District (+2 Schools)/ Polytechnic NSS Programme Coordinator (For NSS Programme Development at +2 Council Level/Polytechnics)
- c. Programme Officers with NSS Units
- d. NSS Volunteers

1. If eligible nominations in NSS Volunteers category i.e. Male or Female are not received as per the numbers mentioned above then committee has the power to merge the awards in same category.

2. In addition to the above, certificates of Appreciation may be given to 45 Best Programme Officers/Principals as per the recommendation of the Coordinators and 5 Programme Officers/Principals as per the recommendation of State NSS Officer on the basis of Field Visit. (Total 50).

4. CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY AND PERFORMANCE EVALUATION

4.1 University/ District (+2 Schools)/ Polytechnic NSS Programme Coordinator: The Programme Coordinator is the key functionary as far as NSS is concerned. Therefore, a dedicated and devoted Programme Coordinator can plan, execute and evaluate the NSS activities in a proper perspective. Despite the prestigious duty of a teacher, he/she is desirous of doing community service and devotes his/her time and energy for community work and for the motivation of NSS volunteers, Programme Officers and institutions of his/ her jurisdiction. For the service of community, it is befalling that his/her services are being recognized by the community

and the institution. Therefore, it is in the interest of NSS that incentives should be given to outstanding NSS Programme Coordinators for their dedication and devotion.

4.1.1 **Eligibility Conditions:** The following conditions should be fulfilled in order to be eligible for consideration for the Award:

- a. The University NSS Programme Coordinator, whose selection has been made strictly as per the NSS guidelines (NSS Manual -Revised- 2006, Part IV, Chapter-3). He/She should have completed three years as University Programme Coordinator including the year *for which* the Awards are being conferred. In this regard, he/she has to furnish certificate from competent authority.
- b. The District (+2 Schools)/ Polytechnic NSS Programme Coordinator, who had worked earlier as NSS Programme Officer for at least three years and as District/ Polytechnic Programme Coordinator has completed three years including the year *for which* the Awards are being conferred. In this regard, he/she has to furnish certificate from competent authority.
- c. The University (which should be duly recognized by UGC/ Central/ State Government) and District should be implementing NSS programmes continuously for at least last 5 years including the year *for which* the Awards are being conferred.
- d. The University/ District (+2 Schools)/ Polytechnic should have a minimum strength of 500 NSS volunteers (i.e. Minimum 05 NSS Units) as on the last date of the Financial Year *for which* the Awards are being conferred.
- e. The University/ District (+2 Schools)/ Polytechnic NSS Programme Coordinator should have achieved 70% of the NSS enrolment and Special Camping targets for last 3 years including the year *for which* the Award is being conferred.
- f. The NSS functionaries under the University/ District (+2 schools)/Polytechnic should not have been convicted by a court of law and there should not be any case/ investigation pending against any of them. In this regard, he/she has to furnish certificate from competent authority.
- g. The University/ District (+2 Schools)/ Polytechnic that has already been conferred with the State NSS Award in NSS Programme Coordinator category, shall not be eligible for the Award again for a period of Five years after the year *for which* the Award was conferred. This is to ensure broad-based representation of Universities/ Districts/Polytechnic.
- h. The University/District (+2 Schools)/Polytechnic NSS Programme Coordinator, who has already been conferred with National NSS Award/ National Youth Award/ State NSS award in NSS Programme Coordinator Category shall not be eligible to apply for State NSS Award in same category. (Although It is clarify that If any NSS Coordinator/ NSS Programme Officer/ NSS Volunteer, who have applied for State NSS Award and conferred with National NSS Awards/ National Youth Award will be eligible for the State Award for same year).

4.1.2 **Criteria for Performance Evaluation:** The Performance of the Universities/ District NSS Programme Coordinator shall be evaluated based of objective criteria, including their achievements in plantation of saplings, blood donation, organization of health related camps, organization of awareness programmes/ rallies/ campaigns on various issues, creation of durable assets through shramadaan, organisation of National / regional/ State/ University/ District/ Polytechnic level programmes and other outstanding achievements. The achievements during last 3 years (including the year *for which* the Award is being conferred) shall be taken into account for this purpose.

4.2 **The Programme Officers and NSS Units:** A teacher who is desirous of doing community service and youth service joins NSS as Programme Officer. As he/she devotes his/her time and energy for community work and for the motivation of NSS volunteers and the service of community, it is befalling that his/her services are recognized by the community and the institution. Therefore, it is in the interest of National Service Scheme that incentives should be given to outstanding NSS Programme Officers for their dedication and devotion.

4.2.1 **Eligibility Conditions:** The following conditions should be fulfilled in order to be eligible for consideration for the Award:

- a. The NSS Programme Officer, whose selection has been made strictly as per the NSS guidelines (NSS Manual -Revised- 2006, Part-VI, Chapter- 2), shall have to furnish certificate in this regard from competent authority.
- b. The Programme Officer to be considered for the Award, he/she shall be in-charge of a single NSS Unit.
- c. The NSS Unit should have been in existence continuously for at least 5 years including the year *for which* the Awards are being conferred.
- d. The volunteer strength of the NSS Unit should be as per guidelines during last 3 years including the year *for which* the Awards are being conferred.
- e. The NSS Unit should have adopted a village/ slum as per guidelines and achieved Special Camping targets during last 3 years including the year for which the Award is being conferred.
- f. The Programme Officer, who is being considered for the Award, should have completed at least 3 years (as on the last date of the Financial Year for which the Award is being conferred) as the Programme Officer of the particular NSS Unit.
- g. The Programme Officer should not have been convicted by a court of law and there should not be any case/ investigation pending against him/ her.
- h. The Programme Officer who has already been conferred with State NSS Award/National NSS Award/National Youth Award in programme officer category shall not be eligible to apply for State NSS Award in same category. (Although It is clarify that If any Programme Officer who have applied for State NSS Award and conferred with National NSS Awards/National Youth Award will be eligible for the State Award for same year)

4.2.2 **Criteria for Performance Evaluation:** The Performance of the NSS Unit shall be evaluated based of objective criteria, including their achievements in plantation of saplings, blood donation, organization of health related camps, organization of

awareness programmes/ rallies/ campaigns on various issues, creation of durable assets through shramadaan, Organization of National/regional/State/ University/ District Level programme and other outstanding achievements. The achievements during last 3 years (including the year *for which* the Award is being conferred) shall be taken into account for this purpose.

4.3 NSS Volunteers:

4.3.1 **Eligibility Conditions:** The following conditions should be fulfilled in order to be eligible for consideration for the Award:

- a. The NSS Volunteer should have completed 2 years volunteership under NSS during the year for which Award is being conferred (since the Award is conferred for a particular year, volunteers completing their volunteership prior to that year cannot be considered for the Award). In other words, the NSS volunteer should have been a student, pursing a regular course, at least for a part of the year for which he/ she is being nominated.
- b. The NSS Volunteer should have completed minimum 240 hours of community service during the 2 consecutive years of volunteership.
- c. The NSS Volunteer should have attended at least one 7 Days Special Camp.
- d. The NSS Volunteer should have attended at least one National/ Regional NSS programme like R.D/ Pre-RD Parade Camp/ IYP/ NSS Mega Camps/ National Integration Camps/ North East Youth Festivals/ National Youth Convention/ Suvichaar under National Youth Festival, Adventure Camp etc.
- e. The NSS Volunteers should not be more than 25 years of age (28 years in case of SC/ST) as on the last date of the financial year for which the Award is being conferred.
- f. The NSS Volunteer should not have been convicted by a court of law and there should not be any case/ investigation pending against him/ her.
- g. The NSS Volunteer who has already been conferred with State NSS Award/National NSS Award/National Youth Award shall not be eligible to apply for State NSS Award in same category. (Although It is clarify that If any NSS Volunteer who has applied for State NSS Award and conferred with National NSS Awards/National Youth Award will be eligible for the State Award for same year).

4.3.2 **Criteria for Performance Evaluation:** The Performance of the NSS Volunteer shall be evaluated based of objective criteria, including their achievements in plantation of saplings, blood donation, attending health related camps, attending awareness programmes/ rallies/ campaigns on various issues and other outstanding achievements. *The achievements shall be considered for the 2-year volunteership period only (including the year for which the Award is being conferred).*

The NSS volunteers should indicate his/ her personal achievements only, and not the achievements of the entire NSS unit. For instance, in the 'saplings planted' category,

he/ she should indicate saplings planted by him/ her personally and not the saplings planted by the entire NSS unit. Similarly, in the 'blood donation' category, he/ she should indicate number of units of blood personally donated by him/ her, and not the total number of units of blood donated by all volunteers in a blood donation camp attended by him/ her.

5. PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION

5.1 Selection Committees: The selection shall be done through a multi-stage objective selection process, starting with senior secondary school/ college level and going up to State level. The composition of Selection Committees at various levels shall be as follows:

- a. **At the Institution level:** The Committee shall comprise of the Principal of the College/ School/ Polytechnic (chairperson), the Programme Officer (convener) and an eminent person (Eminent Person should not be from the same Institute).
- b. At the University Level: The Committee shall comprise of the Vice Chancellor (chairperson), University Programme Coordinator (convener), Dean of Student Welfare/ Director of College Development Council and 2 eminent persons (Eminent Person should not be from the same institution/University). (Minimum 3 Persons required to complete the quorum)
- c. **At the Polytechnic Level:** The Committee shall comprise of the Deputy Director Academic, Directorate of Technical Education (chairperson), Polytechnic Programme Coordinator (convener), Two Principals of Govt. Polytechnics and 2 eminent persons. (Minimum 3 Persons required to complete the quorum).
- d. At the District Level (+2 Schools): The Committee shall comprise of the DEO (chairperson), District Programme Coordinator (convener), Two Principals of Govt. Schools and 2 eminent persons. (Minimum 4 Persons required to complete the quorum).
- e. At the State Level: The Committee shall comprise of the Secretary in-charge of NSS/ Director General/Director Higher Education (Chairperson), Director Secondary School Education, 2 eminent persons (From NGO or other state SNO) and State NSS Officer (Convener). (Minimum 4 Persons required to complete the quorum)

5.2 Other Guidelines/ Instructions: Some other guidelines/ instructions in this regard are as follows:

- a. The Programme Coordinator/ Programme officer and NSS Volunteer of Universities/ Districts (+2 Schools)/ Polytechnics should not recommend any case where even the minimum eligibility conditions, as specified Para-4.1.1, 4.2.1 and 4.3.1 are not met.
- b. Each institution can recommend *maximum* one Programme Officers (along with their NSS Units) and two NSS Volunteers (one Boy & one Girl) to concerned University/ District/ Polytechnic. Recommendations in excess of this number shall be rejected outright.
- c. University/ District (+2 Schools)/ Polytechnic more than 100 NSS units in their jurisdiction can recommend *maximum* one NSS Programme Coordinator, Three

Programme Officers (along with their NSS Units) and six NSS Volunteers (Three Boys & Three Girls), University/ District (+2 Schools)/ Polytechnic having more than 50 NSS units and 100 or less than 100 Units in their jurisdiction can recommend *maximum* one NSS Programme Coordinator, two Programme Officers (along with their NSS Units) and four NSS Volunteers (Two Boy & Two Girl) and University/ District (+2 Schools)/ Polytechnic having more than 5 NSS units and 50 or less than 50 NSS Units in their jurisdiction can recommend maximum one NSS Programme Coordinator, one Programme Officers (along with their NSS Units) and two NSS Volunteers (One Boy & One Girl) & Universities having 5 or less than 5 NSS units in their jurisdiction can recommend *maximum* one Programme Officer (along with their NSS Units) and one NSS Volunteers (Boy or Girl). Recommendations in excess of this number shall be rejected outright.

- d. An individual (i.e. NSS Volunteer, NSS Programme Officer or NSS Programme Coordinator) will not be eligible for State NSS Award if he/she has already been conferred with the NSS Award at National Level by Government of India in same category. (Although It is clarify that If any NSS Coordinator/NSS Programme Officer/ NSS Volunteer who have applied for State NSS Award and conferred with National NSS Awards/National Youth Award will be eligible for the State Award for same year)
- e. The selection of Awardees is normally done on the basis of proposal papers/ documents received from Universities/Districts. However, in case of apparent inconsistencies in the contents of the proposal papers, the Department of Higher Education, Government of Haryana, may seek clarifications from concerned Universities/Districts or get the facts physically verified by deputing officials.
- f. The recommendation should be arranged in the order of merit. The names upto stipulated number of participants in the list would be considered and the rest would be rejected as excess.
- g. The responsibility verification of any information furnished in the proposal by the applicant would lie with the concerned Principal/ Chairperson, University/ District (+2 Schools)/ Polytechnic NSS Coordinator. The State Government would not be held accountable in whatsoever manner for any false information furnished by the applicant in the proposal. In case any information furnished in the proposal is found to be incorrect at any stage of the selection process, the nomination of such awarded would be cancelled.
- h. All the facts indicated in the proposal are to be supported by necessary proof/documentary evidence. In the absence of any such proof, the information indicated in that particular category would not be evaluated and would be awarded Zero marks without any information.
- i. The maximum number of Awards to be conferred from any Single University/ District (+2 Schools)/ Polytechnic having more than 100 NSS units in their jurisdiction shall be restricted to 4 Awards under NSS Volunteers Category and 2 Awards for Programme Officer Category. University/ District (+2 Schools)/ Polytechnic having more than 50 NSS units and 100 or less than 100 Units in

their jurisdiction shall be restricted to 3 Awards under NSS Volunteers Category and 1 Awards for Programme Officer Category. University/ District/ Polytechnic having 50 or less than 50 NSS Units in their jurisdiction shall be restricted to 2 Awards under NSS Volunteers Category, 1 Award for Programme Officer Category and 1 Award for Programme Coordinator category. This is to ensure broad-based representation of Universities/Districts (+2 Schools)/ Polytechnic.

6.1 The nominations for the Award shall be furnished to the State NSS Cell, Department of Higher Education, Government of Haryana, Shiksha Sadan, Sector- 5, Panchkula in the enclosed prescribed Proforma for the year 2022-*23*.

6.2 The application for State NSS Award should be properly binded and each page of application should be numbered. Loose documents will not be entertained and will be rejected outright.

6.3 Pasting of cutting of Newspaper and Photographs should be avoided in the application. Only relevant document/certificates should be attached.

6.4 Kindly ensure to attach the documents point wise and in sequence and not more than 100 pages.

6.5 Incomplete application shall be rejected and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

6.6 The selected Awardees shall be invited for State Awards Ceremony and will be entitled to travel as per the rule & regulations of the Government of Haryana/ NSS Manual. The applicable TA/DA will be borne by the concerned institution from NSS fund/Regular activities grant.
