

1. To increase the Gross Enrolment Ratio of students: It has been observed that not all 10+2 pass out students opt for colleges and universities. Principals to inform of the initiatives and strategies they plan to bring all 10+2 students in higher education.
2. Introduction of Job Oriented Courses: All students enrolled in colleges must study one job oriented subject to make him capable for job market. List of some job oriented courses is attached herewith. Issue is flagged for discussion.
3. Status of Lesson Plans: Principals to report whether lessons are being delivered as per lesson plans or not. Illustrate the measures which are being adopted to check the adherence.
4. Placement of students: Principals to share the details of Placements of students and the efforts taken to ensure maximum number of placements.
5. Status of NAAC Accreditation to be given with the timelines.
6. Progress on passports made in the colleges.
